Seachdain na Gàidhlig

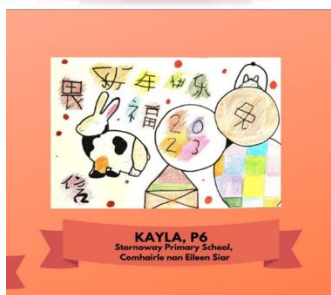
